The broader agenda has been carefully curated to provide attendees with practical insights and real-world learning opportunities, whether working in trail development, land management, tourism, outdoor recreation, or community engagement.

“With such a strong and diverse international speaker line-up, WTC2026 is set to be one of the most significant global gatherings for the trails community,” said organisers. “The program reflects not only the scale of expertise across the industry, but also the shared commitment to building resilient, connected and sustainable trail networks for the future.”
